## **GRADUATION/TRANSFER RATE – STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW DISCLOSURE**

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, and the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, Montgomery College is reporting the graduation and transfer rates of students who entered the College in Fall 2021 as first-time, full-time, degree or certificate seeking students. The graduation and transfer rates are computed based on the student's status three years after entry.

Of 1,486 students who entered as first-time, full-time, degree or certificate seeking students in Fall 2021, 32.4% graduated and 19.3% transferred to a postsecondary institution within three years, making the Montgomery College combined Graduation/Transfer rate 51.7% for the 2021 entering student cohort. The data below reflect Graduation/Transfer rates of the Fall 2021 cohort by race/ethnicity, gender and financial aid status.
