Note for transfer students: Not all colleges accept AP test scores in the same way. Check with all transfer school(s) of interest to determine how your AP scores will be accepted as college credit. Some transfer schools require a minimum score of 4 to earn specific course credit. Most Maryland State public transfer schools accept scores of 3 as direct course equivalents (Frostburg, Towson, UMBC, UMES, UMGC).

State of Maryland AP Credit Transfer Policy to [Maryland Public System Institutions](#): If a student satisfies a **General Education Requirement** at **Montgomery College** with an AP score of 3 (example, if MC grants you credit for FREN 201 based on a score of 3 in AP French Language & Composition and this course fulfills a Humanities General Education Distribution in the MC General Education Program, then the Maryland System transfer school should consider a General Education Program Requirement to be filled upon transfer, even if the MD public transfer school does not accept the AP score of 3 as a Gen Ed Humanities course upon transfer. Students must either complete an AA or AS for this policy to be honored, or for UMD specifically, students should finish the MC General Education Program within an AA or AS degree and [request to have a “General Education Program” stamp](#) applied to their transcripts prior to transfer. Students may need to work with [Maryland Public System Institutions](#) to ensure that this policy is applied after transfer.

Special Considerations for Transfer to UMD College Park or UMD Shady Grove – AP Test Scores of 3 If you plan to transfer to **UMD** and have an **AP test score of 3**, please review the following important points:

1) Major Requirement Courses:

If Montgomery College awards **credit for an AP test score of 3 for a course that is required for your major** at UMD, it is important to **consult with a [UMD Pretransfer Advisor](#)** to determine whether you need to take that course again at MC. **Example:** If you score a 3 on **AP US Government** and MC awarded you credit for **POLI 101 American Government**, UMD will grant you **lower-level elective credit** for this course. If you want to transfer as a Government & Politics major to UMD, you will need to take **POLI 101** as a class at MC to fulfill the GVPT 170 requirement for your major. This policy applies to **any major that requires specific courses, and you earned an AP test score of 3** – meet with a UMD Pretransfer Advisor to discuss the best course of action. But **if your future major does not specifically require POLI 101 = GVPT 170**, it will transfer as a General Education BSSD without the need to repeat it.

2) General Education Program Courses if transferring to UMD and other [Maryland Public System Institutions](#):

If the AP course with a score of 3 is not required for your major but satisfies a **General Education Program** requirement at MC, UMD will **accept the credit** as Elective credit and consider the Gen Ed area to be fulfilled if you complete either the MC General Education Program or an AA/AS degree before you transfer, and you **won't need to repeat the course** either at MC or UMD. For more details, refer to the **State of MD General Education AP Transfer Policy**.

Art Majors at UMD – UMD requires ARTT 150 Intro to Art Theory as a core course for [all tracks of the UMD Studio Art major](#). MC's ARTT 127 Art Appreciation transfers to UMD as ARTT 150 if taken as a class at MC; however, a score of 3 on AP Art Studio/Design and Art History exams will be accepted as Lower Level Elective credit upon transfer. Art majors transferring to UMD with any AP Art Exam Score of 3 earning credit for ARTT 127 at MC should either take ARTT 127 as a class at MC to fulfill the UMD major core requirement of ARTT 150 or plan to complete ARTT 150 at UMD after transfer.

UMD BUSINESS MAJORS – An AP score of 4 or 5 is required to receive credit for ECON 201 or 202 @ UMD. Montgomery College will grant ECON 201/202 credit for an AP Macro or Micro score of 3; a score of 3 on AP Macro or Micro will be accepted by UMD as lower level elective credit. Additionally, a score of 3, 4 or 5 on AP Statistics does not satisfy a UMD Business Gateway Statistics requirement.

AP Notes for UMD Business Major requirements:

- **AP MACROECONOMICS score of 3 only** – take ECON 201 Principles of Economics I as a class at MC or take at UMD after transfer
- **AP MICROECONOMICS score of 3 only** – take ECON 202 Principles of Economics II as a class at MC or take at UMD after transfer
- **AP STATISTICS score of 3, 4 or 5** – if you are granted credit for MATH 117 at MC, you need to also take BSAD 210 Statistics as a class at MC to meet the UMD Business Statistics Gateway requirement. ** UMD's Smith School Business accepts AP Statistics as STAT 100 upon transfer, this class does not fulfill UMD's Gateway Business Statistics requirement. UMD will grant Lower Level Elective credit for an AP Stat score of 3 and this can apply as an elective for a Business major both at MC and UMD; take BSAD 210 Stat for Business Admin. at MC to transfer with both STAT 100 Elective credit and BSAD 210 Business Statistics credit. The AP Statistics Test does not meet UMD's content requirements to qualify as UMD's *Business Statistics course*.

UMD GOVERNMENT & POLITICS Major and GVPT - International Relations Track (GVPT/IR) –

- **AP US Government score of 3 only** – GVPT/IR majors, take MC POLI 101 American Government as a course at MC. If you are not a GVPT/IR major, UMD will accept a score of 3 in AP US Government as a Behavioral/Social Science to fill General Education Requirements, no need to repeat at MC.
- **AP Microeconomics score of 3 only** - ECON 202 Microeconomics is required for GVPT Majors & GVPT/IR Track Majors - take ECON 202 as a class at MC.

UMD INFORMATION SCIENCE MAJORS – AP Precalculus or AP Calculus Scores of 3 only – take MATH 165 Precalculus or MATH 150 Elementary Applied Calc at MC to satisfy Info Sci Math Requirement; also, with an AP Psychology Score of 3 – note that PSYC 100 is required for Info Sci. majors.

For AP PRECALCULUS or AP CALCULUS test scores of 3 – MC grants credit for MATH 165 Precalculus. If your major at UMD requires you to take MATH 181 Calculus I or higher, the credit from a score of 3 granting credit for MATH 165 Precalculus does not need to be transferable as a Precalculus course to UMD. But if your major at UMD requires less than MATH 181 Calculus I, ex. your UMD major requires a general college-level math of Precalculus or lower, discuss this with a [UMD Pretransfer Advisor](#), as UMD will grants lower level elective credit for AP Precal and Calculus exams with scores of 3.

UMD AP PSYCHOLOGY TEST SCORE OF 3: If your major specifically requires PSYC 100 General Psychology as a Major Requirement (examples of majors are **Education, Information Science, and Psychology**) – take PSYC 100 General Psychology as a course at MC. If your UMD major does not specifically require PSYC 100, UMD will accept a score of 3 in AP PSYC as a Behavioral/Social Science to fill General Education Requirements, no need to repeat the class at MC, see AP Credit Transfer Policy on Page 4.
