Drawing Techniques for Beginners: Media Explored

For this class, you will need the following materials:

- Drawing paper pad heavyweight 9 x12 (smooth surface recommended)
- Mixed Media paper pad toned Tan or Gray 9 x12 (Strathmore brand is terrific choice)
- Drawing Pencils HB, 2 H, 4H, 2B, 4B, 6B, 8B (Artist's Loft brand pencil set from Michael's Arts and Crafts store is a great choice). Any other brand is welcome.
- Optional: Sketch pad(any size) or loose paper for taking notes or practicing techniques
- Soft eraser (often included in Artist's Loft pencil set in Michaels)
- Mechanical eraser such as Tombow brand Mono zero eraser or any other brand
- Blending tools (stomps and tortillons) (often included in pencil sets in Artist's Loft set of pencils)
- Colored pencils set of 24 or more (any brand)
- White Posca marker (0.7 mm)
- White jelly roll pen
- Photographs for fast practices
- Ink pen Black Pigma Micron set of 3 (size 03, 05)
- Charcoal pencils set of 2 - 3 or similar (General, Windsor & Newton or any other brand)
- White charcoal pencil or white pastel pencil any brand
- Watercolor set of 12 pans or more (any brand including Crayola)
- Water container any
- Few brushes synthetic (small medium large)
- Palette tray (any) to mix colors

Optional to keep home: Fixative spray (such as Grumbacher matte spray or any other brand for pencil, charcoal artwork) No spray during class.
